WATERWAY & LOCATION WHERE WORK WILL BE DONE: Gowanus Canal, Brooklyn. From entrance of canal to end of canal, work will take place from 3rd st bridge to northern end of canal (north of Union St. bridge. Barge transloading will take place just north of 9th St. bridge, and barge transiting from 9th st bridge out to Bayridge Flats anchorage and on to Clean Earth for processing.

PASSING ARRANGEMENTS/Time to move vessels to not impede navigation: Updated changes to previous LNM: The Gowanus Canal is closed to all recreational boating between 9th Street and Butler Street, including use of the 2nd Street public boat launch, at the direction of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), the lead federal agency for the Gowanus Canal Superfund Site, due to the ongoing construction of the dredging and capping remedy of the canal until further notice unless specific advance written authorization is granted by USEPA.
